'safe strangers'.





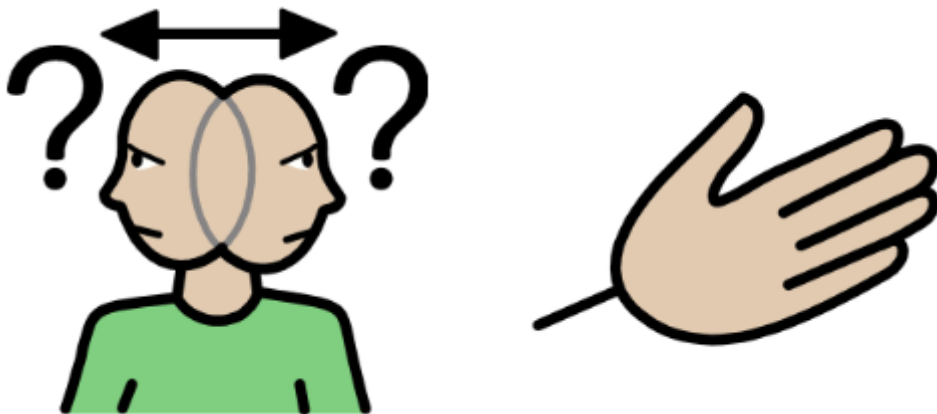

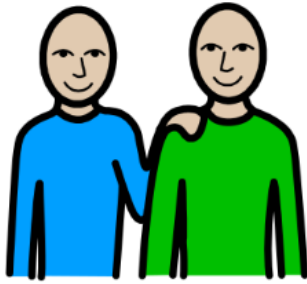

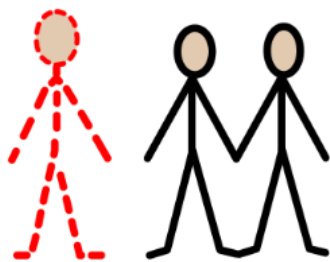
