Everyone is happy when I remember to share.

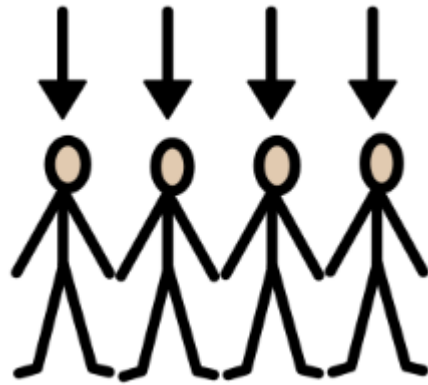
