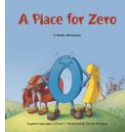


## Mathematics

**Place Value** – x3 weeks including number to 1000, partitioning, place value headings, counting in 1s, 10s, 25s, 100s, rounding, comparing numbers, negative numbers and Roman numerals.

**Four Operations** – x4weeks including adding and subtracting 3-digit numbers, 4-digit numbers and introducing exchanging, multiplying by 1, 10 and 100 and recalling multiplication and division facts for the 3, 6, 9 and 7 times tables.



## Science

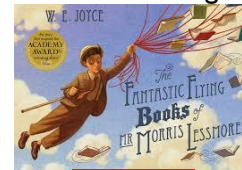
### States of Matter

In this unit, the children will be learning about the three states of matter and exploring the changes that occur between them.



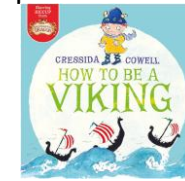
## Guided Reading

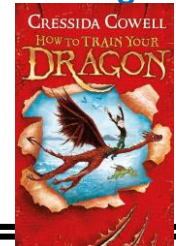
