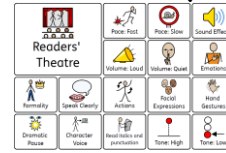

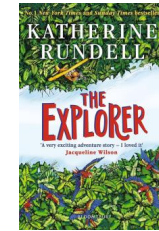
Readers' Theatre & Book Banter

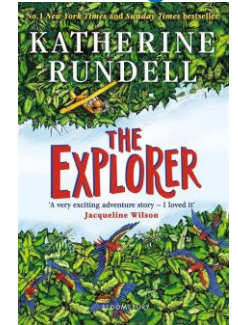
