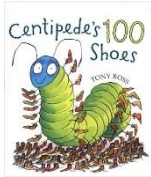


Mathematics

Children to use Canterbury and our local environment as a case study to explore key similarities and differences between maps, land use and landscape in these two locations.

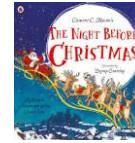

Music Ukuleles

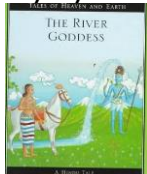
