

## Mathematics – White Rose

- Addition and Subtraction: add and subtract 100s & 1000s; add a 2/3-digit number to 2/3-digit number; add two 3-digit numbers; subtract 2-digit number from 2-digit number; subtract a 2-digit number from a 3-digit number.
- Four Operations – including adding and subtracting 3-digit numbers, 4-digit numbers and introducing exchanging, multiplying by 1, 10 and 100 and recalling multiplication and division facts for the 3-, 6-, 9- and 7-times tables.

## Science

Understanding of the significance of biodiversity and ecosystems within the rainforest, and examining these through:

- Living organisms and habitats
- Classification

## Guided Reading

- Little Wandle guided reading based on a range of texts.
- Wide range of stories shared across the term in addition to weekly book banter sessions.

## English

We will explore the term by exploring all things spooky. The children will create adjectives to describe a spooky setting and complete storyboards to write their own spooky stories!



Children will move on to a Poetry unit centred around Remembrance Sunday. There will be a focus around Haiku poems and their unique structure.

With the up-and-coming Christmas Production, we will be focussing on reading and learning our lines speaking aloud with tone and intonation.

## P.E.

We will be focusing on a range of gross motor skills as well as P.E skills this term.

Children who integrate into partner classes will access P.E with their year groups.
