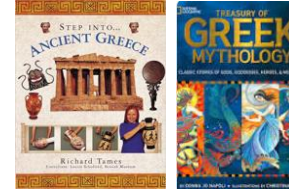

Greek mythology:

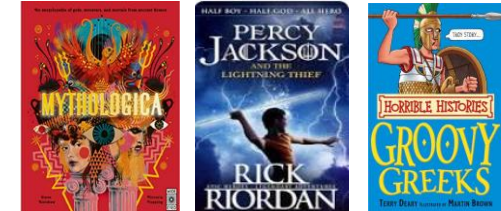

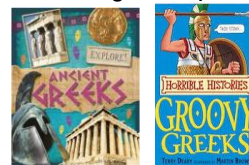


History

Celebrating Difference

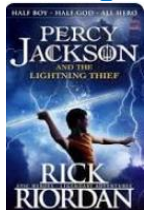
Using our new whole school approach programme named **Jigsaw**, we are able to access a whole range of fantastic units.
