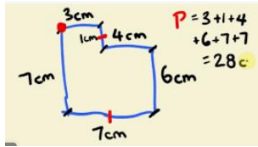


Mathematics

Multiplication and division x 4 weeks. Formal written method for multiplications, multiplying 3 digits by 1 digit. Bus stop method with up to 3 digits.

Length and perimeter

Children measure and calculate perimeter of rectilinear shapes and polygons.



Science

- Recognise that living things can be grouped in a variety of ways.
- Explore and use classification keys.
- Recognise that environments can change and that this can sometimes pose dangers to living things.

- Non-Chronological Reports** – The children will create their first non-fiction piece of writing in this unit based on the rainforest animals in Central / South America. Our non-chronological reports will be based on a rainforest animal of their choice and will explore their habitat, diet and appearance.

Marvellous Middle

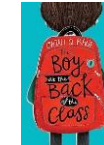
We will bring the Mayan civilisation to life in our Kic Theatre session!
