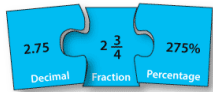


## Mathematics



### Spring Term White Rose curriculum:

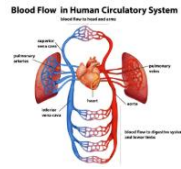
- Decimals

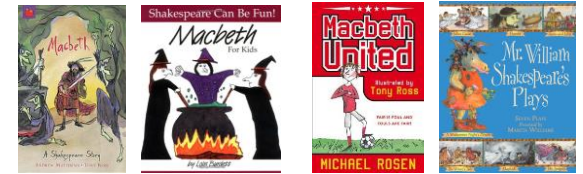

### Macbeth by William Shakespeare

Children will be introduced to England's greatest playwright when we study the tragedy of Macbeth. Supported by drama in class and as part of KIC Theatre, pupils will explore the characters, plot and rich language of Macbeth in a variety of ways. Their understanding of the key characters will support them to write a letter from the point of view of Lady Macbeth, and the tense moments leading up to Duncan's death will be captured in a dramatic narrative.

### Animation

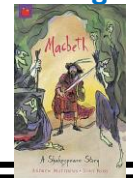
Developing digital skills to create stop-motion animations.
