## Communication and Language

Children will continue to practise following two-step or three-step instructions.  
Children will continue to develop their concentration skills and remain focused during group activities.  
Children will continue to practise listening to their peers and responding respectfully.  
Children will learn language linked to traditional tales and use them in their play.  
Children will retell stories using actions or picture prompts and use story language when acting out narratives.

## Expressive Arts and Design

Children will know that you can make marks using a variety of tools and media including hands, toys and sticks and will create art using lines, spirals and zig zags.  
They will explore a range of warm, cold and waterproof fabrics and investigate suitable ways to join fabric as they make a cloak for Little Red Riding Hood.  
Children will explore musical instruments and learn how to play them quietly/loudly as they prepare for Cinderella's ball!

#### Gymnastics

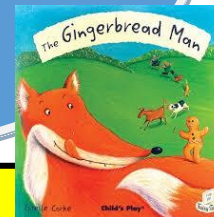
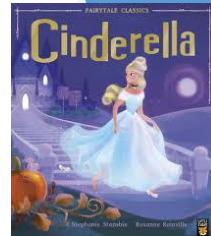
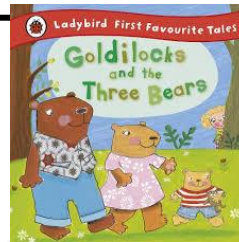
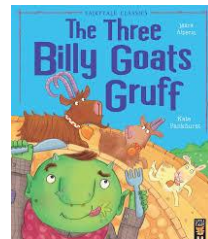
Children will explore different take off positions and landing positions and will practise assessing risk and landing safely whilst jumping.
