


Mathematics

We will be focusing on a range of gross motor skills as well as P.E skills this term.

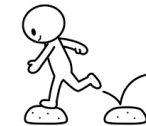
Children who integrate into partner classes will access P.E with their year groups.
