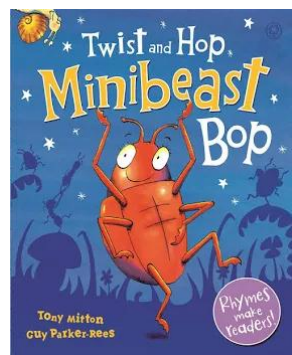
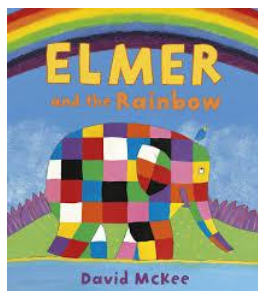
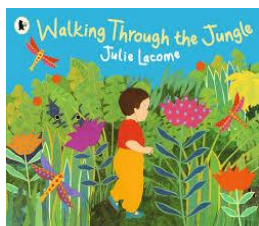

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

- Children will further develop their turn-taking skills through a variety of circle time games and parachute games.

Communication and Language

- Children will be encouraged to identify familiar objects and properties by pointing to pictures or objects such as "Can you show me the big worm?".
- Children will develop their understanding of question words such as 'Who?', 'What?' and 'Where' when they are exploring in nature and hunting for minibeasts.
