Multiplication and Division:

- Children will recall their knowledge of counting in 2s, 5s and 10s and apply this to their learning if multiplication.
- Children will explore doubling and make equal groups as they begin to think about division.

Fractions:

- Children will make and find halves and quarters of shapes.
- Children will then move on to finding fractions of numbers.

Children will investigate the different clothes worn in a castle and use their knowledge of properties of materials to design the best suit of armour for a knight.

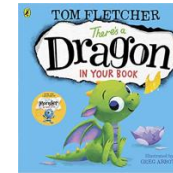


English

Key Skills to be Covered:

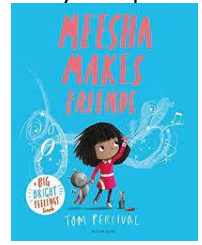
- Segmenting to write words.

Relationships

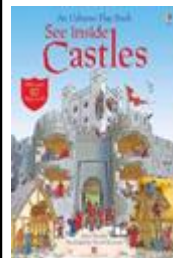
Children will talk about how to make friends, solve problems with friends when they occur and know how to help themselves and others when they feel upset.

- Children will compare the differences between living in a castle and living in their home.



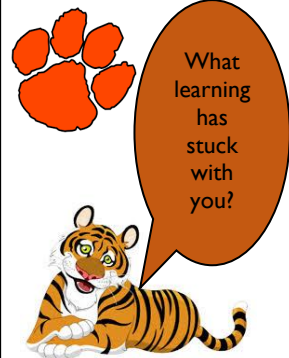
Year 1 Term 5 'Castles'

Children will develop their ball skills. Children will master basic movements such as throwing catching and dribbling and develop their target hitting skills.



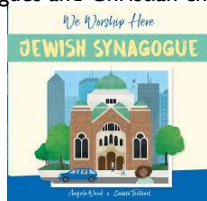
Computing Music Creation

Fieldwork walk – as part of our geography learning we will take a short walk around our locality.

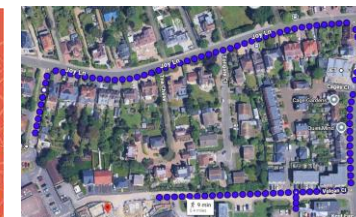
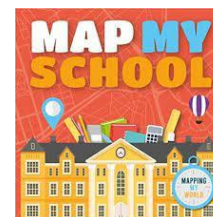
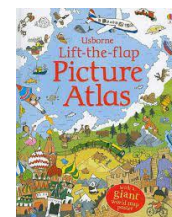
Fabulous Finish
