

## Mathematics

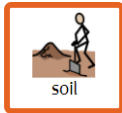
**Fractions:** We will be revisiting Fractions and learning how to add and subtract them as well as learning how to find fractions of a set of objects.

**Money:** Working with pounds and pence and practising adding/subtracting amounts.

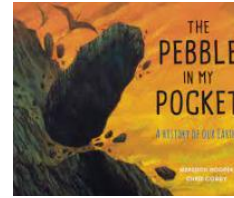
**Time:** Learning to tell the time on analogue and digital clocks.

## Science

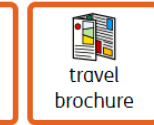
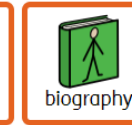
**Rocks, Fossils and Soil**

We will learn about how and why people of different faiths pray.



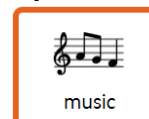
## Geography
