## BREAKFAST AND AFTER SCHOOL CLUB REMINDER

May I remind all parents and carers that any wraparound care will need to be pre-booked and pre-paid at least 3 days in advance using our online booking service; this is essential for our system to work effectively and also to ensure that we have the correct ratio of staff to children each day. You can book your child in for single sessions or long-term blocks. Parents and carers, please note that in order to secure your child's place in these clubs, it is absolutely vital that all sessions are paid for in advance and that there is no outstanding debt.

Please note that our After School Club capacity is 60 so you will be unable to secure a place if numbers exceed this. Last minute emergency requests for children to access Breakfast Club or After School Club may be granted subject to availability, supervision and pre-payment.
