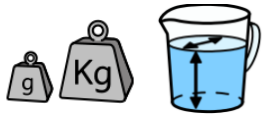


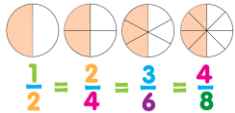
Mathematics

We will also be developing our understanding of fractions.



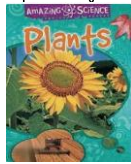
Science

Guided Reading

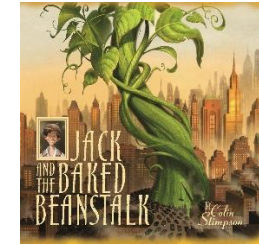
- Little Wandle guided reading based on a range of texts.
