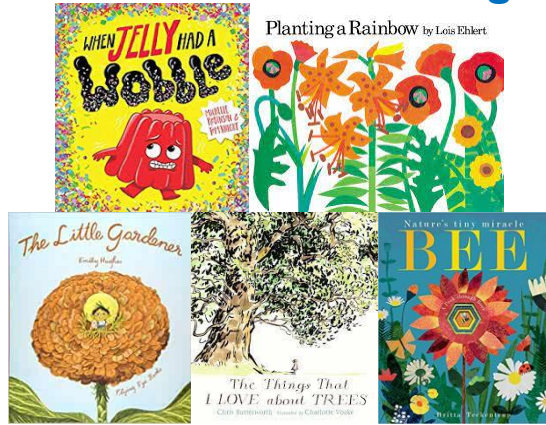


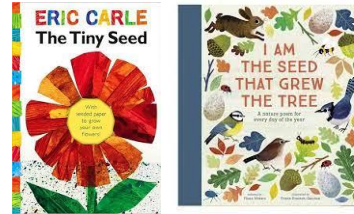
This term we are reading...



Science

I wonder how things grow?

- During forest school sessions children will name a variety of common wild and garden plants, including deciduous and evergreen trees.
- Throughout the term, children will identify and describe the basic structure of a variety of common flowering plants, including trees.



English

Key Skills to be Covered:

- Develop use of key spellings and how we use suffixes and prefixes when writing words.
- Further consolidation of sentence structure with a focus on making sentences longer.

Writing Opportunities:

- Fairy tales (Jack and the Beanstalk)
- Bee and plant diagrams with labels and captions.



PSHE

'Changing Me'

- Children will consider how they change as they grow, their bodies and what makes boys and girls different.
- Children will explore their own feelings and how they can manage any feelings of worry as we consider the transition to Year 2.
- Children will consider what will be the same and what will be different as they move to Year 2.



Mathematics – White Rose

Numbers to 100:

Children will develop their ordering, comparing and tens and ones with numbers to 100.

Money:

Children will identify and compare coins.

Time:

Children consider the language of time such as before and after and then learn to read clocks to the hour and half past the hour.

We will use White Rose workbooks that will become familiar to them in Year Two.

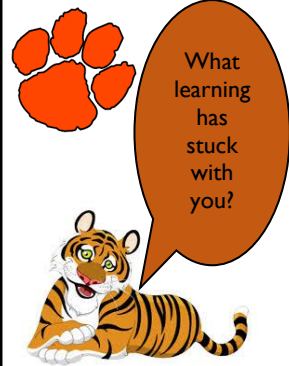


Year 1 Term 6

Design and Technology

Children will develop their understanding of mechanisms by role playing different traditional tales and learning how different sections of stories can be made into moving pictures. Children will then explore different types of mechanisms and create their own moving picture based on a traditional tale.
