

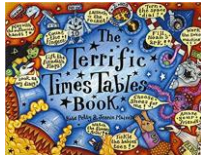
## Mathematics

**Position and Direction:** Children understand points around a compass and movement.

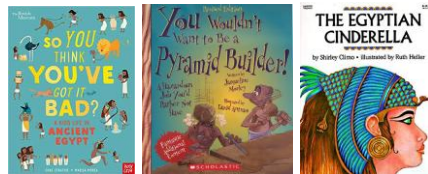


## History

Now the children have a strong foundational knowledge of life in Ancient Egypt, they will examine Egyptian artefacts from Tutankhamun's tomb.

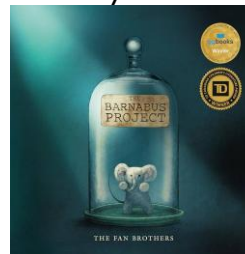
Children will also be trying to break out of the Ancient Egyptian escape room!

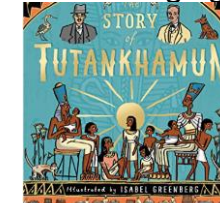
