Physical Development

Gross Motor Skills - Manipulation and Co-ordination:

Swimming – children will continue to develop their swimming skills during weekly lessons

Children will continue to practise sustaining concentration during more complex tasks and develop their conversation skills, taking turns to share their ideas and views.

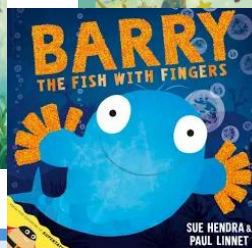
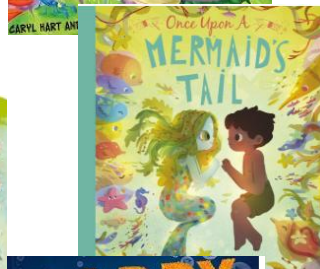
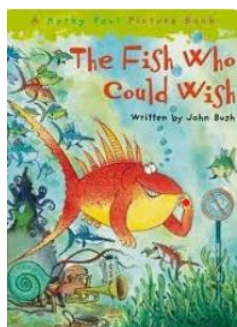
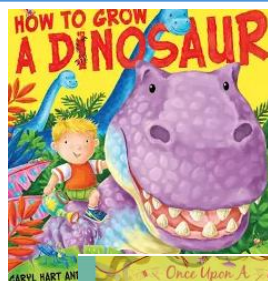
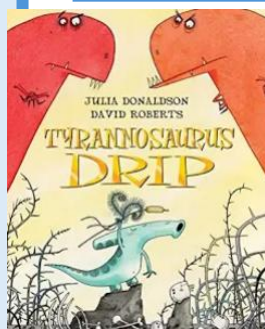
Maths (White Rose)

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

Changing Me – Moving into Year One

Children will learn about changes in their routines, environments, and feelings, gaining an understanding of what transitions are and how their bodies and emotions can respond to them.

They will develop skills to talk about their feelings, use simple coping strategies, seek support from trusted adults, and celebrate their progress as they take their next steps in their learning journey.
