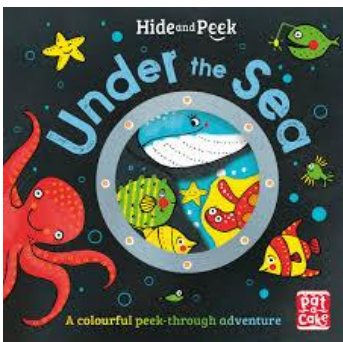
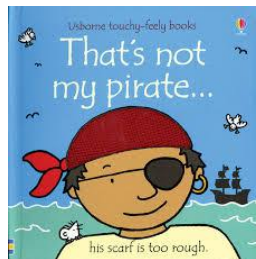


Term 6

Baby Room Going Places!



Personal, Social and Emotional Development

- Turn-taking games such as rolling the ball and going down the slide will support babies' friendship development. Though this looks a little different for babes we will continue to provide lots of opportunities that promote parallel play alongside adult support with turn taking.
- Babies will further develop their sense of self with sensory activities that allow key workers to narrate their play using their name.

Communication and Language

- When exploring 'The Beach', babies will play hide and seek in our tuff trays. Babies will be encouraged to say what they have found 'a fish', 'a shell' etc. to further develop their use of vocabulary.
- Babies will be singing lots more action rhymes, such as 'The Wheels on the Bus' and 'This Little Piggy' to give them opportunities to understand new words.

Physical Development

- During Sports Week, babies will be further encouraged to engage in ball play. They will kick, throw and catch balls with their key worker and peers.
- As we explore transport, babies will use the wheeled toys such as scooters and tricycles and develop their balance and coordination to move around the garden with confidence.
- Babies will be further encouraged to eat independently at snack times by feeding themselves and selecting their own snack.

The World Around US

We will use our senses to explore the different textures of the seaside and engage in lots of water play as we think about the beach and 'Under the Sea'.

We will explore different modes of transport and sing different songs such as 'The Wheels on the Bus' and explore how different objects move.
