Going Places



Personal, Social and Emotional Development

Children will further talk about their emotions and how they can manage them through a variety of circle time and small group activities including mirror play and puppets. Older toddlers (getting ready to transition to preschool) will talk about how change can make us feel.

Expressive Arts and Design

Children will be encouraged to move and dance to music and consider how the different music can make them feel.

Communication and Language

- Children will be encouraged to further develop their pretend play when exploring 'going to the shops' and saying please and thank you for their shopping.
- When exploring the seaside, children will identify familiar objects and their properties such as the 'shiny shell' or 'big pebble.'

Understanding the World

We will explore different places through a variety of sensory activities and make our own seaside with sand and water.

Toddlers will continue to develop their understanding of everyday routines such as coking and shopping as we role play 'going to the shops'.
