Personal, Social and Emotional Development

- Babies will explore the setting and try new things; establishing their own sense of autonomy around their peers.
- Babies will begin to find ways of calming themselves, through being calm and comforted by their key worker.
- Adults and babies will work together to establish knowledge of likes and dislikes and express their own preferences in the setting.

Communication and Language

- Babies will sing lots of action rhymes such as 'Head, Shoulders, Knees and Toes' to give babies opportunities to understand new words and identify their own body parts.
- Babies will use gestures such as waving, pointing and simple signs to communicate with the adults in the setting.



Physical Development

- Babies will explore lots of stacking toys and build independently as their coordination develops.
- At meal and snack times babies will be encouraged to try a range of foods and make their own choices in the foods as they try to eat independently.
- Babies will be encouraged to react to music through clapping, stamping and other actions while enjoying different genres of music.

The World Around Us

- We will show attention to sounds and music.
- We will use our fingers and hands to explore paint as well as other parts of our bodies and different tools.
- We will explore our setting and repeat actions that have an effect such as noisy toys.
