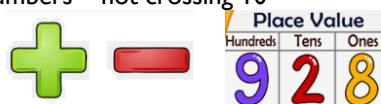

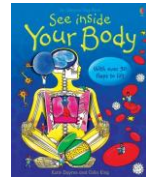


Science

Animals, including Humans

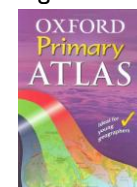
Children will use their Science learning to create a 3D Healthy Eating plate.
