Science

Forest School focus

- What do we wear in different seasons? Children to explore how the weather and temperature changes throughout the seasons.

Weather

- Children to explore the different types of weather and make prediction based on their knowledge of the seasons.

Key Skills to be covered:

- Children will recap the sounds they learnt in Reception and apply these sounds to longer words.

Recording a special song to share with parents and carers: '1, 2, 3 - it's good to be me!'

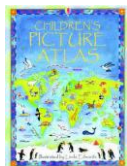

Geography

Where do I live? I wonder where my friends live?

- Children to explore their place in the world, what is important to them and what their house/ location looks like.
- Children to explore the different weather in their locality.
- Discussions around seasons especially through visits to forest school as we transition from summer to autumn.



P.E.

Hit, Catch, Run

- Children will be taught to catch and throw a ball over a short distance.
- They will begin to run between bases to score points.
- Children will learn to support one another, showing encouragement for teammates and good sportsmanship.

- Children will learn to move a mouse or track pad and left click to select, drag and drop an object.
