White Rose

Multiplication and Division:

- Children will recall their knowledge of counting in 2s, 5s and 10s and apply this to their learning of multiplication.
- Children will explore doubling and make equal groups as they begin to think about division.

Fractions:

- Children will make and find halves and quarters of shapes.
- Children will then move on to finding fractions of numbers.

Science

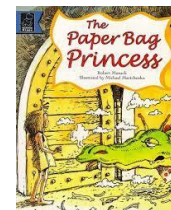
I wonder what castles were made from?

The children will learn about different materials and their properties. They will compare and group different materials based on their properties.



English

- Children will rewrite the story of the paper bag princess using adjectives to make the story interesting.

Relationships

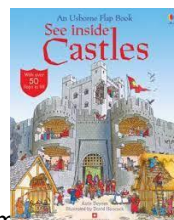
Children will talk about how to make friends, solve problems with friends when they occur and know how to help themselves and others when they feel upset.

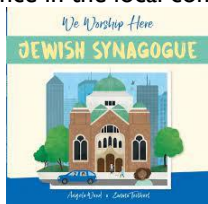
Run, Jump, Throw

Children will celebrate the King's Coronation – how exciting!

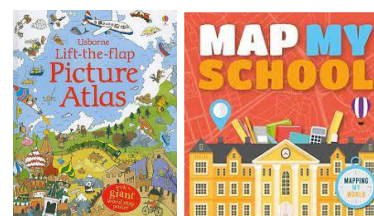
Fabulous Finish
