

Mathematics

Addition/subtraction: Missing numbers, mixed addition and subtraction.

Shape: Recognise and describing 2d and 3d shapes.

Money: Counting money using pounds and pence, calculating with money. Comparing different amounts of money.

Multiplication and division: Multiplication picture sentences, arrays, introducing the x symbol, making doubles, times tables, sharing and dividing by 2, 5 and 10.

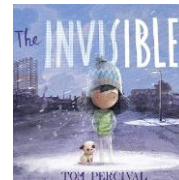
