Showcasing the children's work in the 'Pop-Up' Mountain Museum.



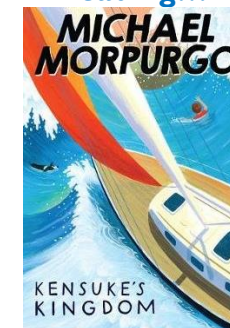
