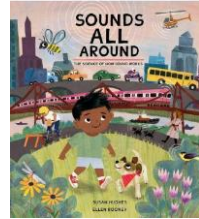

Year 5 will be revising and developing their Football skills, including passing, receiving and effective pitch communication!

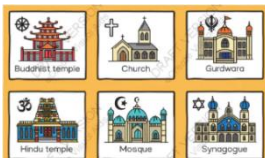


## Computing

### Healthy Me

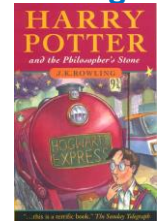
Using our whole school approach programme, **Jigsaw**, we are able to access a whole range of fantastic units.
