

Mathematics

Length: Measuring in cm and m, ordering and comparing length.

Measurement: Measuring mass, capacity and temperature.

Number: Fractions – Recognising unequal parts, make equal parts, recognise and find $\frac{1}{2}$ $\frac{1}{4}$ $\frac{1}{3}$, unit and non-unit fractions, equivalent fractions, find $\frac{3}{4}$, count in fractions up to a whole.

Revising number facts for the x2, x5 and x10 times table.

Science

Sound

This term will be identifying how sounds are made and recognising how vibrations from sounds travel through a medium to the ear.

We will also be looking for patterns between the pitch and volume of a sound and features of the object that produced it.

Guided Reading

English

- Poetry – writing poems inspired by nature and spring.

Geography
