Perimeter and area

Forces

Explain that unsupported objects fall towards the Earth because of the force of gravity acting between the Earth and the falling object.

Identify the effects of air resistance, water resistance and friction, that act between moving surfaces.

Recognise that some mechanisms, including levers, pulleys and gears allow a smaller force to have a greater effect.

Readers' Theatre and Book Banter:

Children will be continuing to develop their ability to read aloud with fluency and expression to ensure they are aware of their audience.

We will be reading a variety of texts linking to our topics this term.

Migrants (diary entry writing) –

Children will have the opportunity to read a gorgeous picture book, understanding how groups of animals move from one place to the next taking all of their equipment and homes with them. Through guided reading sessions and sentence building in English lessons, children will empathise with one of the characters to write their own moving diary entry.
