

Mathematics - White Rose

- Explore 3D shapes
- To 20 and beyond
- How many now?
- Sharing and grouping
- Children will recall their knowledge of counting in 2s, 5s and 10s and apply this to their learning if multiplication.
- Children will explore doubling and make equal groups as they begin to think about division.
- Children will make and find halves and quarters of shapes.
- Children will then move on to finding fractions of numbers.

Relationships


- Children will talk about how to make friends, solve problems with friends when they occur and know how to help themselves and others when they feel upset.

- Compare past and present transport




Wyburn Term 5 'Castles and Coasts'

Run, Jump, Throw


Children will develop their skills in running, jumping and throwing by negotiating obstacles, bounding and considering starting positions when running.

We will build our own beach, castle and moat outdoors!


Fabulous Finish
