Measure

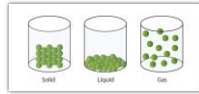
- Understand how to convert to metric units

- Use knowledge of solids, liquids and gases to decide how mixtures might be separated, including through filtering, sieving and evaporating.
- Give reasons for the particular uses of everyday materials, including metals, wood and plastic.

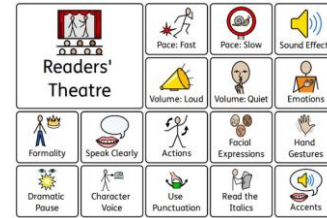


Guided Reading
