Living Things

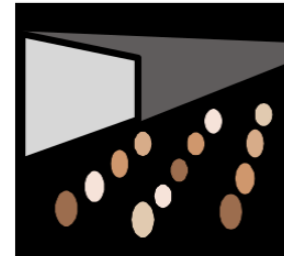
We will continue to explore the characteristics of living things.
