Place value: Understanding tens and ones, partitioning, comparing objects and numbers.

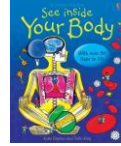
Addition/subtraction: Counting in 2s, 5s and 10s, exploring fact families, learning number bonds, knowing 10 more and 10 less than a number, practising adding and subtracting 1- and 2-digit numbers.

Science

Animals, including Humans

Identify that animals, including humans, need the right types and amount of nutrition, and that they cannot make their own food: they get nutrition from what they eat.

Identify that humans and some other animals have skeletons and muscles for support, protection and movement.
