Y6 will put together a 'Pop-Up' mountain museum to describe why people climb mountains covering famous explorers and expeditions.

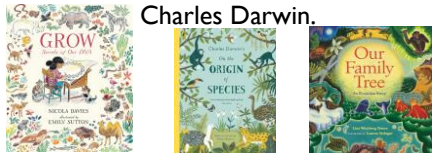


- Different types of mountain and where they are located

Showcasing the children's work in the 'Pop-Up' Mountain Museum.



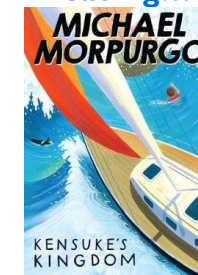
