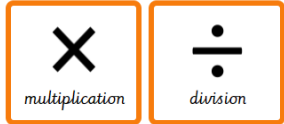


## Mathematics

- Percy Jackson and the Lightning Thief - The children will write a short narrative based on the book and film

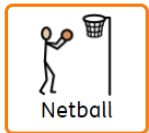
- Christmas Advert - The children will be creating a short piece of tension writing based on the famous 'Kevin the Carrot' advert.

As we finish the term near Christmas, the children will take part in a spectacular Oysters Christmas music production.

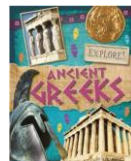


## History

## PSHE

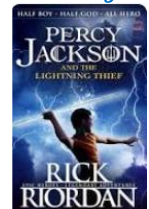
### Celebrating Difference
