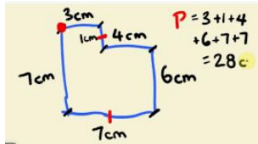


Mathematics

Multiplication and division x 4 weeks. Formal written method for multiplications, multiplying 3 digits by 1 digit. Bus stop method with up to 3 digits.

Length and perimeter

Children measure and calculate perimeter of rectilinear shapes and polygons.



Science

- Recognise that living things can be grouped in a variety of ways.
- Explore and use classification keys.
- Recognise that environments can change and that this can sometimes pose dangers to living things.
