## **Terms 3 & 4 Extended Learning Clubs** **Monday 23rd January – Friday 24th March 2023 3:15pm – 4:15pm**

Starting Monday 23<sup>rd</sup> January, the Joy Lane staff will once again be providing a wide range of Extended Learning Clubs and in-school enrichment activities to broaden the learning experiences of the children. The intention is that the Extended Learning Clubs on offer continue to nurture, develop and stretch pupils' talents and interests.

We will be offering a broad range of quality clubs for the children to sign up to; however, due to reduced funding for schools and increased costs, we will be charging a fee per session for the clubs. The exception being that if your child is in receipt of **Free School Meals**, then the School Pupil Premium allocated will meet the cost of the clubs.

I hope you agree that the list of clubs attached provides excellent value for money, and I do hope that all the children make good use of them.

During Terms 3 and 4, the clubs will run from Monday 23<sup>rd</sup> January to Friday 24<sup>th</sup> March (8 weeks/sessions). Places will need to be booked and paid for in advance using our Arbor booking system. All Extended Learning clubs must adhere to the appropriate adult / child ratio, and we, therefore, have to limit numbers accordingly.

Booking will go live via Arbor from **Friday 13<sup>th</sup> January and close on Wednesday 18<sup>th</sup> January 2023**. Please note that those families in receipt of Free School Meals are entitled to claim a full refund after signing their children up to and paying for the club. The government has directed all schools to ensure that we are supporting all FSM children so that they have access to all facilities and club options that the school provides.

**Please see attached a brief synopsis of the clubs, which includes details of where to collect your child at 4:15pm once the club has finished.**

Our staff are very kindly providing the extra-curricular opportunities for your children; therefore, impeccable behaviour is expected at all times. All children who sign up for a club are expected to attend every session to comply with our Safeguarding procedures. If a child is unable to attend, you must inform the school office so the necessary amendment can be made to the club register.

**After the club has finished, all children will need to be collected by an authorised adult.**

**Years 5 & 6 Children – If you give permission for your child to walk / cycle home independently, please contact the school office for the necessary arrangements to be made.**
