

Mathematics



- **Number - Place value**
Children will continue to develop their understanding of how many tens and how many ones there are in a number. They will count backwards and forwards with numbers to 20 and write numbers to 20 in numerals and words.
- **Number – Addition and subtraction**
Children will develop their addition and subtraction with numbers to 20 and will add by making 10 and subtract crossing 10.

Children will develop their understanding of different materials and what everyday objects are made from. Children will describe the properties of different materials and compare and group together a variety of everyday objects on the basis of their properties.

English

- The children will create a space poster as we learn about the first explorers in space!
- Children will create a fact file on David Attenborough as we look at his wonderful explorations!
- Using their knowledge of adjectives children will rewrite the story of Lost and Found.

PSHE

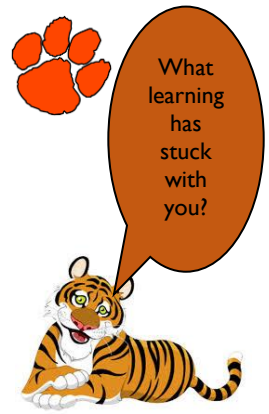
Dreams and Goals

KIC Theatre – children will enjoy a theatre session based on their learning.

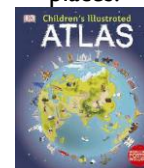
Fabulous Finish
