Year 3

Multiplication and Division

We will learn how to multiply 2-digit by 1-digit numbers with exchanges. We will also learn how to divide 2-digit by 1-digit numbers with and without remainders.

Year 4

Multiplication and division \times 4 weeks.

Formal written method for multiplications, multiplying 3 digits by 1 digit. Bus stop method with up to 3 digits.

Length and perimeter

Children measure and calculate perimeter of rectilinear shapes and polygons.

3. Old Enough to save our planet'

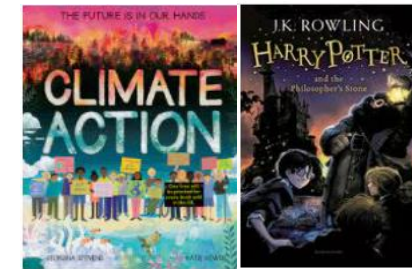
Weekly Book Barter

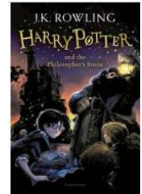
