## Science Forces

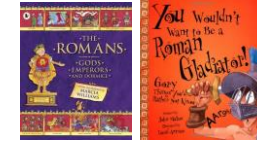

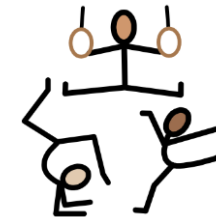

## EHCP Targets

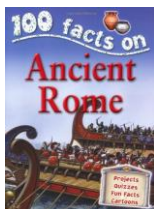
We will continue to progress towards our EHCP targets through our 'Learning to Learn' time and targeted interventions.
