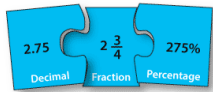


Mathematics

Macbeth by William Shakespeare

Children will be introduced to England's greatest playwright when we study the tragedy of Macbeth. From drama, supported by KIC Theatre and a trip to the British Film Institute, to comic strips, pupils will explore the characters, plot and rich language of Macbeth in a variety of ways. Their understanding of the key characters will support them to write a letter from the point of view of Lady Macbeth, and the tense moments leading up to Duncan's death will be captured in a dramatic narrative.

Art

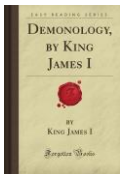
How does art speak to an audience if there are no words?

The term rounds up with our highly anticipated Year group trip to the British Film Institute to investigate how Shakespeare is used on film and screen.



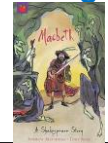
