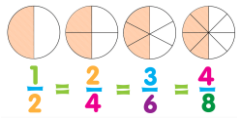


Maths - Fractions

This term we will be exploring fractions!



We will also be developing our understanding of mass and capacity.

Science - Magnets

In the science unit we will be continuing with our learning about forces and moving towards magnets use forces to work.

We will observe how magnets attract and repel each other and attract some materials and not others.

We will compare and group together a variety of everyday materials on the basis of whether they are attracted to a magnet, and identify some magnetic materials.

We will describe magnets as having two poles and predict whether two magnets will attract or repel each other, depending on which poles are facing.

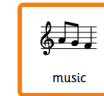
This term we will be creating silhouette images.

Poetry and Art Showcase

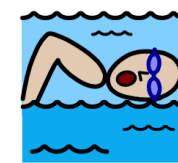
We will be inviting you to view your child's work from our Nature poetry unit after school at the end of Term 4. (More information to follow!)

Netball and Swimming

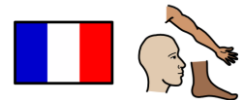
In PE this term we will be learning the basic rules and skills needed to play netball, including dodging and moving to create space and mastering chest, bounce and shoulder pass.
