

## Mathematics - White Rose

**Multiplication and division** - To recall multiplication and division facts for the 2-, 5- and 10-times table, to recall double and half facts and recognise odd and even numbers.

**Length and Height** - To measure in centimetres and metres, compare and order lengths and height.

## Science - Magnets

In the science unit we will be continuing with our learning about forces and moving towards magnets use forces to work,

We will observe how magnets attract and repel each other and attract some materials and not others.

We will compare and group together a variety of everyday materials on the basis of whether they are attracted to a magnet, and identify some magnetic materials.

We will describe magnets as having two poles and predict whether two magnets will attract or repel each other, depending on which poles are facing.
