### White Rose

Traveling on a maths journey through fluency, reasoning and problem solving

### Perimeter and area

Finding the area and perimeter of rectangles and compound shapes.

### Shape

Measuring lengths and angles.

## Science

### Properties and Changes of Material

Investigating how materials change their states of matter. Compare and group together everyday materials on the basis of their properties, including their hardness, solubility, transparency, conductivity. Give reasons, based on evidence from comparative and fair tests, for the particular uses of everyday materials, including metals, wood and plastic.

## Guided Reading

### Readers' Theatre and Book Banter:

Children will be continuing to develop their ability to read aloud with fluency and expression to ensure they are aware of their audience.

We will be reading a variety of texts linking to our topics this term.



## English

### Migrants (diary entry writing and poems) –

Children will have the opportunity to read a gorgeous picture book, understanding how groups of animals move from one place to the next taking all of their equipment and homes with them.

Through guided reading sessions and sentence building in English lessons, children will empathise with one of the characters to write their own moving diary entry.



## PE

### Rounders

Year 5 will be able to learn an array of tactical aspects of rounders and apply these within a game setting towards the end of the unit.

These are some of the topics we will be learning this term through Jigsaw:

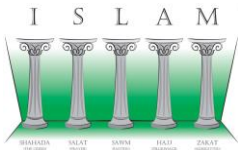
- Knowing how to make friendships
