

Mathematics

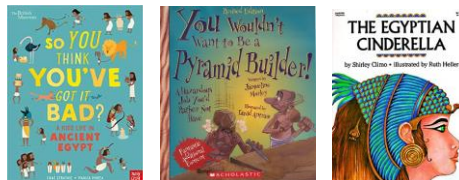
Decimals including making a whole with tenths and hundredths. As well as comparing, ordering, and rounding to the nearest whole number.

Science Sound
