

Mathematics

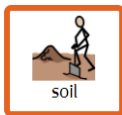
Fractions: We will be revisiting Fractions and learning how to add and subtract them as well as learning how to find fractions of a set of objects.

Money: Working with pounds and pence and practising adding/subtracting amounts.

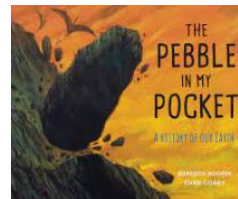
Time: Learning to tell the time on analogue and digital clocks.

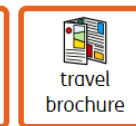
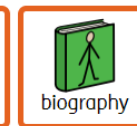
Rocks, Fossils and Soil

We will learn about how and why people of different faiths pray.



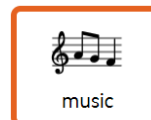
Geography
