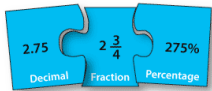


## Mathematics



### Spring Term White Rose curriculum:

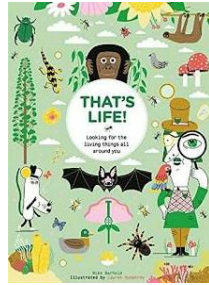
Children have showcased their Maths learning in the SATS in Term 5 and now they will keep their learning ticking over in preparation for secondary school, with a focus on:
