Children will be learning about the changes humans experience as they develop from birth to old age, including puberty. They explore these changes through timelines, research and comparing human development with that of other animals.

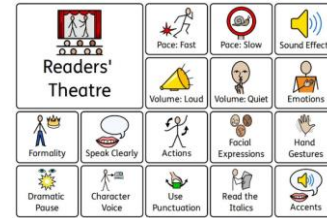


Guided Reading

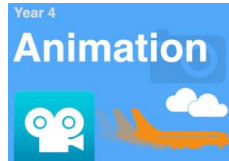
Athletics

Children will become historians, investigating changes in an aspect of social history, such as crime and punishment from the Anglo-Saxons to the present day.



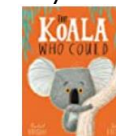
