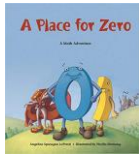
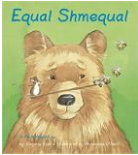


Mathematics

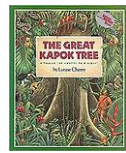
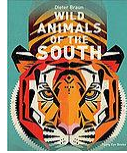


Statistics (2 weeks) including interpreting bar charts and pictograms, finding the sum and difference, reading and drawing our own line graphs.

Living Things and their Habitats

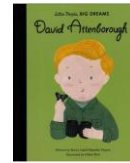
- Recognise that living things can be grouped in a variety of ways.

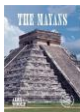
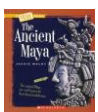
